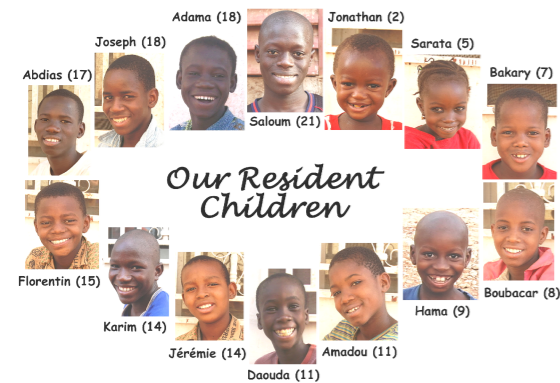


Rescuing Lives

- ◆ Every good Muslim family gives one boy away to a Muslim teacher to get points with Allah.
- ◆ Mali has thousands of street children, nearly all boys.
- ◆ They have no voice and no advocate.
- ◆ They are used for human sacrifices, for prostitution and as slaves.



Street children – Every night we open our doors to let the street children sleep on our base, give them dinner and breakfast, have worship and Bible study together.



Our Resident Children

Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress... (Jam 1:27)

Resident children – Those who love Jesus and want to start a new life are taking into our house and start school.



Our Non-Resident Children

Non-resident children – We help children of poor families who need our help for food, clothes, medical care and tuition.

A child sponsorship is \$60 per month and covers all the child's needs. Every child has an email address so he/she can stay in touch with his or her sponsor. There is also the option of tagging their pictures with your name on Facebook so you regularly see new pictures of them.

- ü In the 10/40 window in the heart of West Africa.
- ü Former French colony.
- ü Twice the size of Texas.
- ü Tenth-poorest nation in the world.
- ü Average annual income \$190.
- ü Two thirds (semi)desert.
- ü Two thirds farming.
- ü Two thirds of its 13 million people under the poverty line.
- ü Only Muslim nation with religious freedom.
- ü 90% Muslim, 9% pagan.
- ü Half the population under 15.
- ü Child sacrifices, trafficking, forced labor.
- ü Life expectancy 47 years.
- ü Women and children not valued.
- ü 1.5 out of 4 children never turn 5.
- ü Polygamy, female circumcision, forced child marriages.
- ü Few churches, and often dead.



PROPERTY

in the capital of Bamako

- Ø Bamako with 2.2 million inhabitants
- Ø growing by 200,000 people per year
- Ø child trafficking, forced labor, child sacrifices
- Ø concept of orphanage unknown
- Ø property in Yirimadio
- Ø on the foot of a hill on the edge of town
- Ø new developing part of town
- Ø no city electricity, water or telephone
- Ø property deeded to *Centre Apostolique Malien* by government

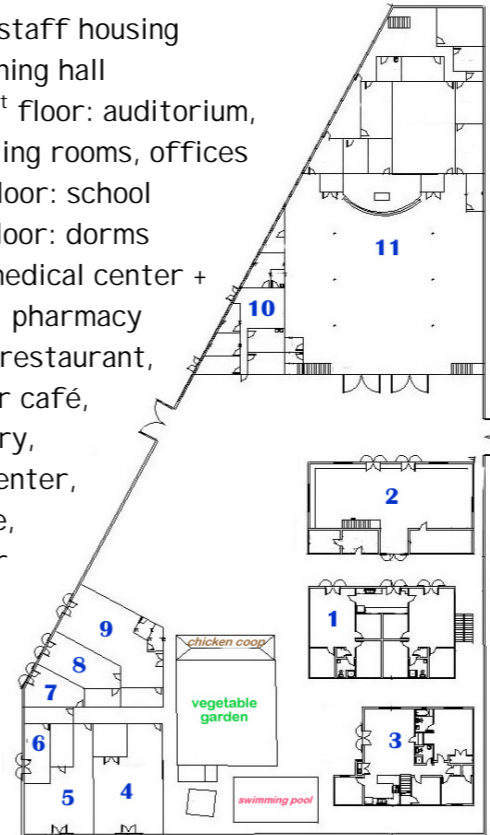

RADICAL CONCEPT

Community Center for 200 children and staff.

- 1+3 staff housing
- 2 dining hall
- 11 1st floor: auditorium, meeting rooms, offices
- 2nd floor: school
- 3rd floor: dorms
- 10 medical center + pharmacy
- 4-9 restaurant, cyber café, bakery, carpenter, store, tailor

-Nov 2017

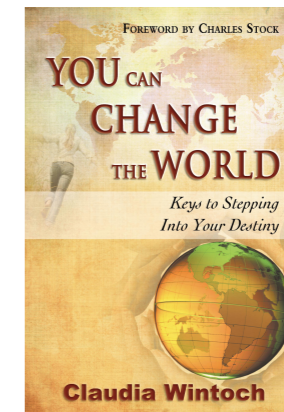


REACHING MALI

In 2006 we started going into unreached villages with the gospel, always seeing signs, wonders and miracles, and grew to have 8 churches in total. In 2010 we lost 5 of the churches due to a team member's lack of integrity. We now have:

- a church on our base in Bamako, founded 2004
- a church in the village of Goro, planted in 2007
- a church in the village of Dara, planted in 2008
